Handicapped Accessibility

Parking

- You may park in the contract lot C48-F. The receptionist will ensure a parking space is available for you.
- You will need to obtain a permit from the receptionist in Shevlin Hall room 115, or a student clinician or supervisor may distribute one to you. Your parking permit must be clearly displayed, hanging on your rear-view mirror.
- In the rare event that a parking spot is not available for you, the Julia M. Davis Speech-Language-Hearing Center will validate your parking stub for a campus public parking lot. The receptionist will notify you in advance of your appointment, if there is no availability in the C48-F lot.

Entering the Building

 Once you have parked, head towards the back of Shevlin hall. The accessible entrance is located at the top of the ramp. There is a lift just inside the doors.

Lift Operation Information

- To enter the lift, press and hold the metal CALL button next to the lift door until the lift stops moving and the door opens. Note that the door swings outward. If you take your finger off the CALL button, the lift will stop lowering/raising to your desired location.
- To operate the lift once inside, press and hold the black button of your desired floor (to reach the office you will use the button labeled "2") until the lift stops moving and the door opens. If you take your finger off of the button, the lift will stop.
- When you reach the main floor, the lift will stop and the door will open automatically.
- Turn left at the end of the small hallway and then follow the winding hallway. At the end of the winding hallway, turn right. Shevlin Room 115, the main office, will be on your right.
